Watch *Oh Jerusalem* with your small group. Allow participants opportunity to share their thoughts on images or points that particularly stood out, things that intrigued or raised questions for them.



Read Amos 3:7 and Daniel 9:24-26 out loud with your group. Allow time to consider the texts and reflect on the case presented in the film.



1. Consider the Biblical statement that God reveals the future through His prophets. How convincing do you find the data concerning the coming of the Messiah? What is most (or least) compelling about the case presented?

2. Rabbi David Rosen states, "When Jesus died, and there was no end to the exile and to Roman persecution, there was no ingathering and there was no universal peace, the Jewish attitude to the Jesus followers was, 'Well, you must have been wrong'." How do you respond to this argument? Was there something about the Messiah's role Jewish scholars may have missed? Were the Jews looking for a different "type" of Messiah? Why is this significant both historically and spiritually?

3. Several of the presenters cited the perfect fulfilment of Daniel's prophecy as providing the conviction and the motivation to both trust the Bible and seek to know Jesus. How does the case for Christ effect you? Is there a personal aspect to this, or is it merely an interesting intellectual exercise? Discuss.

4. How do you respond to the idea that there may be a God who knows the future, and who has a plan for us and our world?



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
